There are several options to fulfill this requirement. See your academic advisor for a specific list. MATH 1332 & 1342 do not fulfill Texas Wesleyan's core and you will be required to take a different math if you do not earn Texas Core Complete. ECON 2301 required for major. ENGL 2323 feeting das prerequisites for upper level coursework.

Elective courses should be selected according to the intended university to which you will transfer. See your academic advisor for assistance with course selection. Texas Wesleyan Recommends HIST 2321 & 2322 as they apply to the major. You must earn a grade of "C" or better in English 1301 and the selected college-level mathematics course and receive a GPA of at least 2.00 on all college-level course work.
