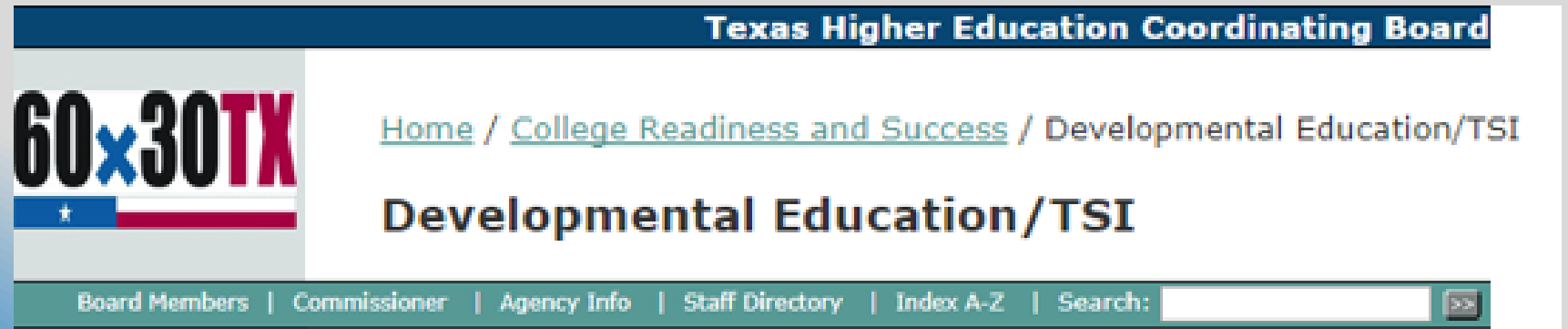

How do Advisors & Faculty access student reports?

Testing directors can create Site Manager Reporter access for advisors and faculty.

- Each credential is unique to a person; testing directors are not allowed to create generic credentials for an entire department to share. E.g., User Name: "Advising" and Password: "Department1" is not allowed under the license agreement.
- Testing directors determine the length of access, typically one semester at a time.
- Credentials must not be shared with others; the platform keeps a log of who is in the system at a given moment and security violations are attached to a particular user name and password.
- Because this is student test data, all rules and regulations around privacy apply and credentials must be guarded and treated appropriately.


