SPCH 1311 – Introduction to Speech Communication This is a (CB 090) Core course.
CHOOSE ONE: **BIOL 1408** – Biology for Non-Science Majors * This is a (CB 030) Core course. **OR**
BIOL 2406 – Environmental Biology* This is a (CB 030) Core course.

PHYS 1405 – Elementary Physics I* This is a (CB 030) Core course.

CHOOSE ONE: **GEOL 1401** – Earth Sciences for Non-Science Majors * This course satisfies EC-6 degree. **OR**
GEOL 1403 – Physical Geology* This course satisfies 4-8 and Special Ed EC-12 degree.

HIST 1302 – United States History II* This is a (CB 060) Core course.
CHOOSE ONE: **ARTS 1301** – Art Appreciation* This is a (CB 050) Core course. **OR**
MUSI 1306 – Music Appreciation* This is a (CB 050) Core course.
